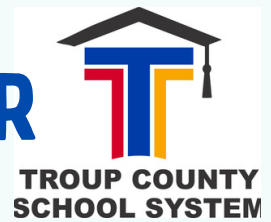

- ✓ Ask your child daily: "What did you learn today?"
